- **Canteen Pricing:** From September, there will be a small increase in the cost of meal deals. The price will be £2.60 and will ensure we can continue to provide the high-quality ingredients, fresh preparation, and excellent service that our pupils deserve, amid rising food and operational costs. The price of the break and lunch 'Grab n Go' items outside of the main meal deal will also be increasing by a marginal 5%. The Free School Meals allowance will be increased to cover this price difference.
