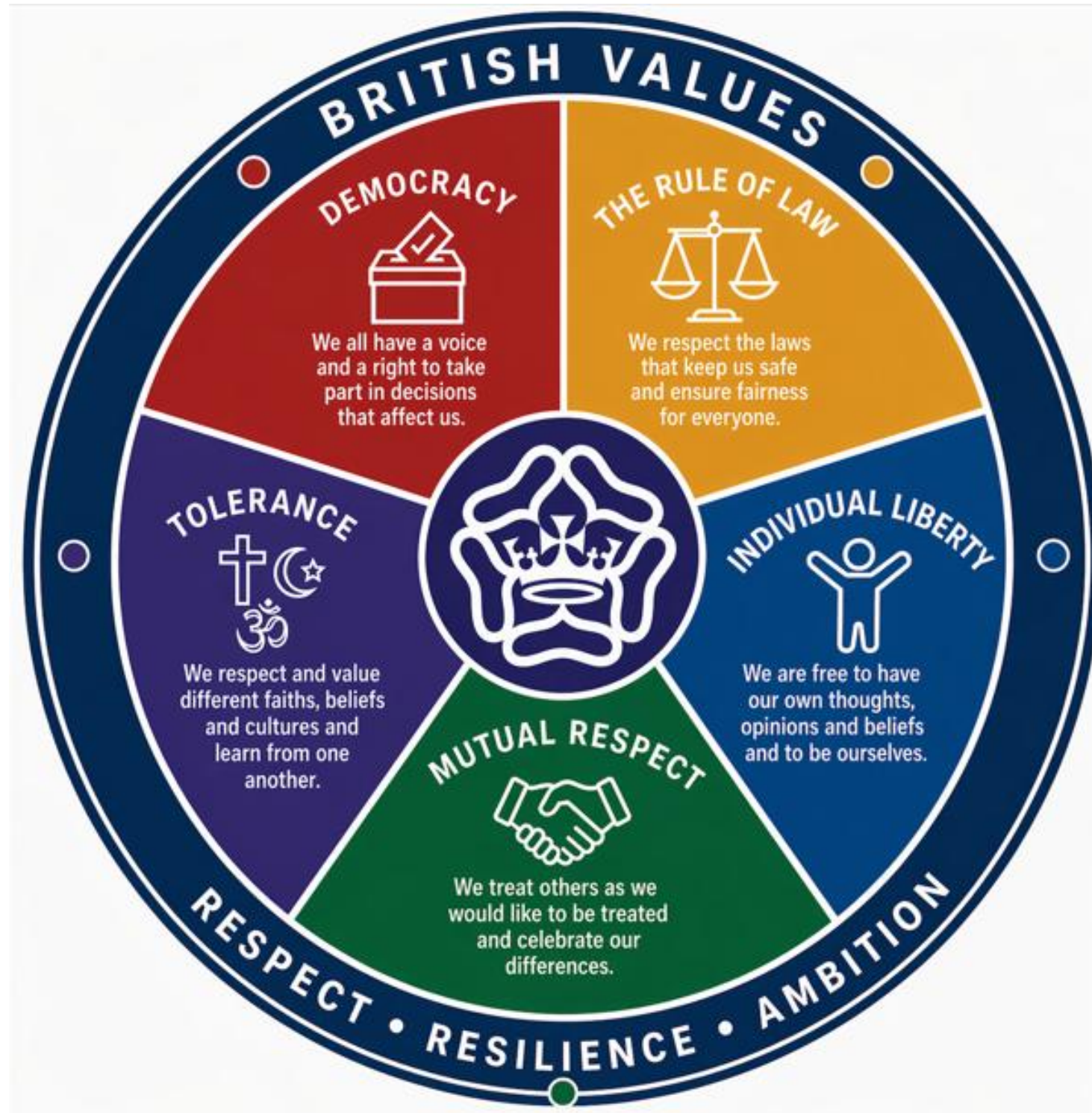

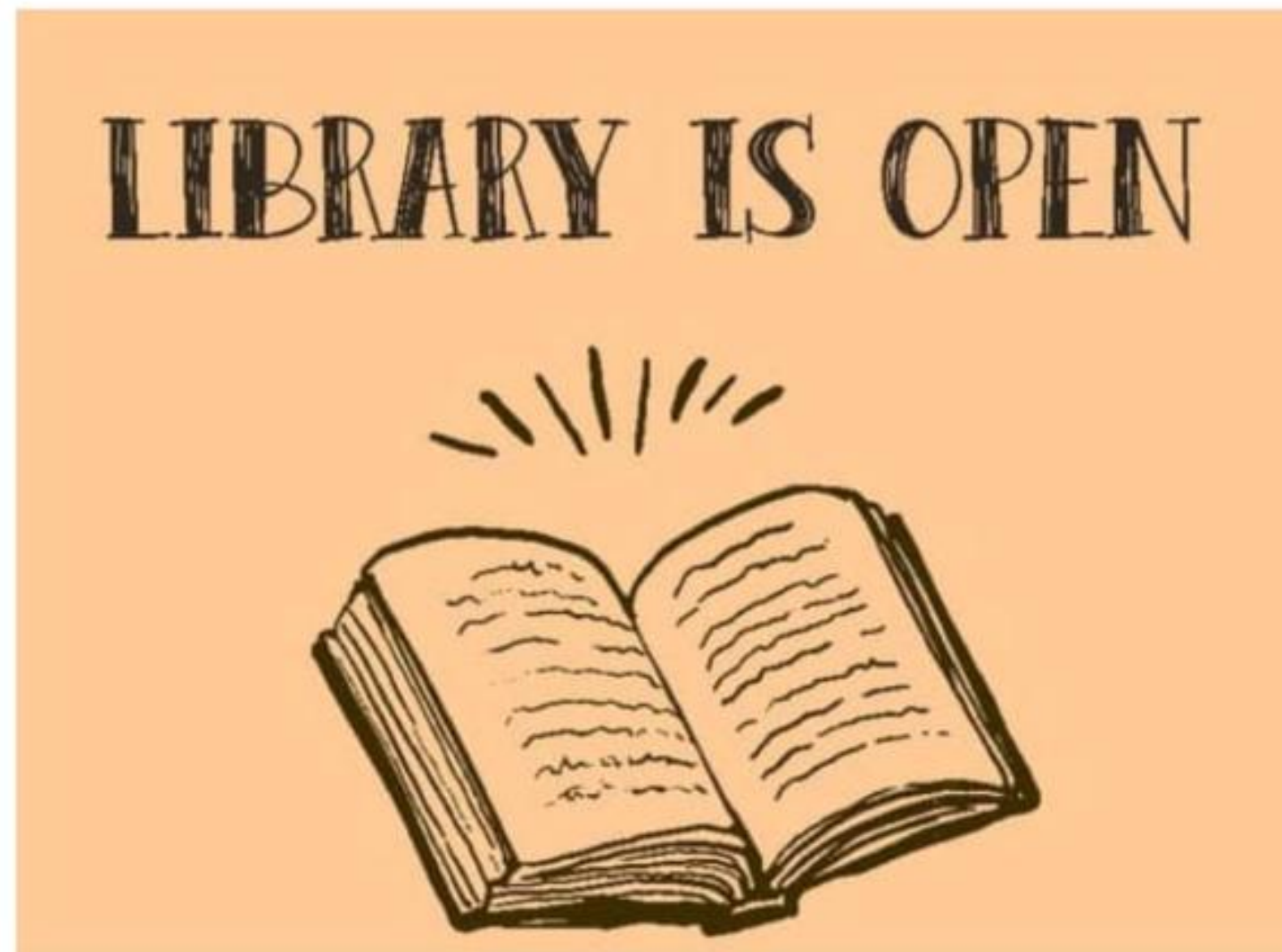

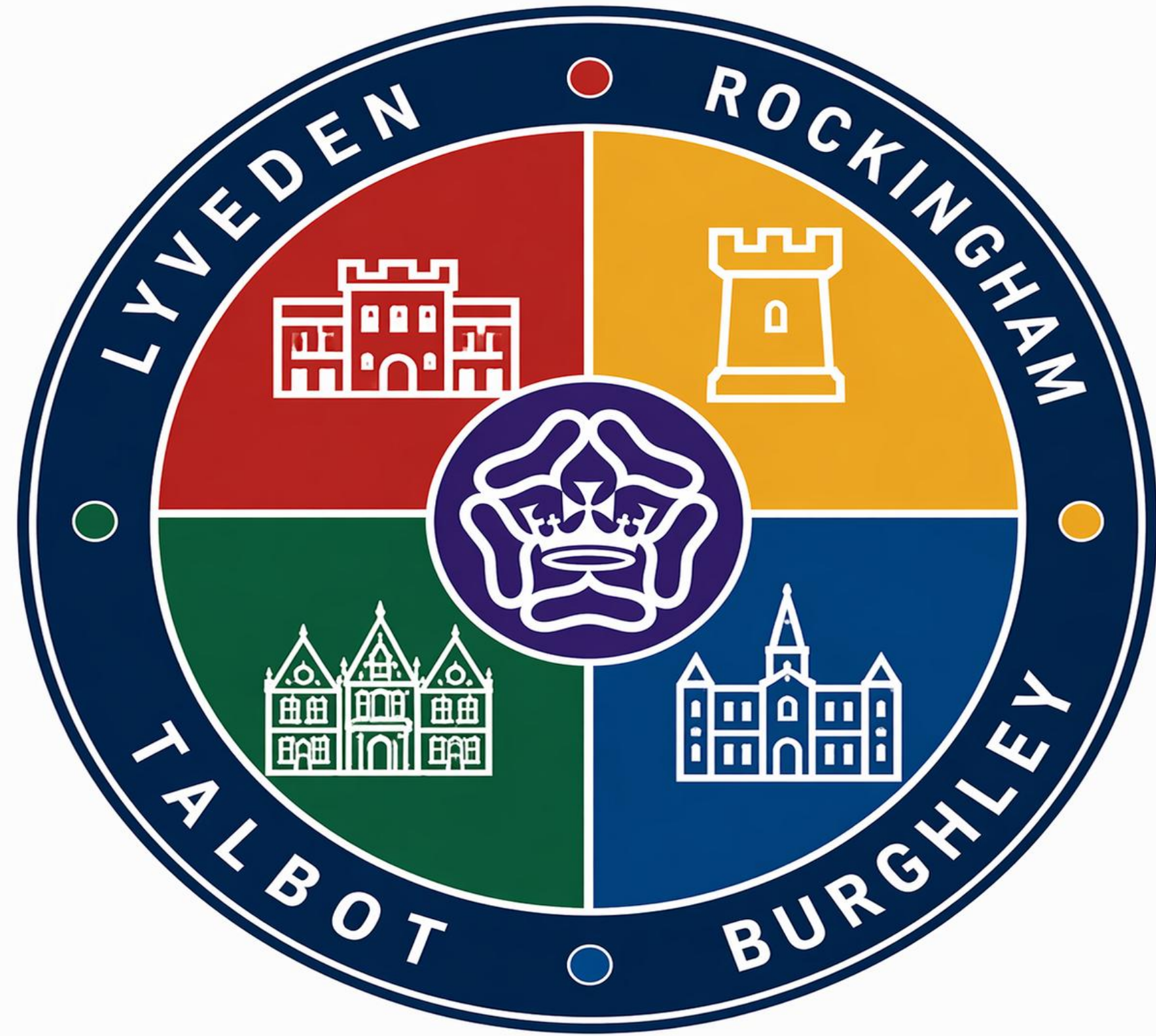

New 'tap in' system for House competitions

We will be introducing a new 'tap in' system this half-term which will be a quick and easy way to register your involvement in all future House competitions.

Why are we doing this?

We would like to capture accurate records of your involvement in House competitions and challenges. This will also help us track closely how many of you are currently getting involved and allow us to plan more carefully for future events.

The system uses your existing ID cards.

What do I need to do?

- 1) When you arrive to a House competition find the member of staff in charge.
- 2) Use your existing ID card to 'tap in' on the device which will be connected to a laptop or ipad.
- 3) That's it! Your name is automatically added to the register, and you will be awarded House points for your involvement.

Uniform correct at all times

A reminder of the following
