Please find below details regarding plans for our final week of term. Please read the information carefully regarding uniform requirements and finish times.

### **Culture Day Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July**

On this day, all students will take part in a range of cultural workshops, giving them the opportunity to experience different aspects of culture, including dance, art, sport, language and music. The aim is to celebrate what makes each individual unique while learning from the rich cultural diversity within our school community. Through these experiences, students will develop curiosity, open-mindedness, empathy and citizenship.

We encourage students to come to school in clothing that represents their own culture. The day will be non-uniform, and students who do not regularly wear cultural dress may wear their usual own clothes. To ensure the integrity of the event, **students should only wear clothing that reflects their own culture**. All outfits must be appropriate for school and modest. Culture can also be expressed through music, sport and community involvement, and students who are members of uniformed organisations (such as Scouts or CCF) are welcome to wear their uniform.

The canteen will be open as usual and will offer a special Culture Day menu. Students are also welcome to bring food that reflects their own culture. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to celebrate their customs and share them with others. **Due to allergies students must not share food**. Cups and cutlery will be provided by the school, so students should not bring their own.
