Dear Parent/Carer,

RE: Geography Hunstanton Trip

As part of your child's Geography course there is a requirement to carry out a certain number of hours 'in the field'. In order to meet this requirement, we have arranged for a trip to Hunstanton on Tuesday 30th June 2026.

In Year 10, the purpose of this trip is to experience fieldwork to collect information and skills for next summer's examinations. As such students will be carrying out primary research both in the town and on the beach area. Fieldwork is required as part of the exam specification and is examined in Paper 3.

Students will be required to wear school PE kit for this trip to help to ensure they are identifiable when carrying out their fieldwork. If students do not have PE kit to wear we have a supply of PE items in lost property which we can lend. They will also need to bring sun protection such as hats and sun cream and water to stay hydrated.

Please see below for an outline itinerary of the day (timings are approximate depending on traffic):

- **Depart 9am from PWS Coach Park**
 - We will be travelling by coach to Hunstanton. Students should travel to school by their usual methods and gather by the green gates next to the new sports hall to be registered on the busses. Students do not need to go to form.
- **Arrive 10.30 at Old Hunstanton**
 - Fieldwork on the beach; including quadrats, observation and sketching of cliff profile and management, beach profiling. After an initial set up talk and demonstration of techniques students will collect data in groups. Class teachers will be moving between groups assisting with techniques and providing advice.
- **Transition between Old and New 12.30 – 12.45** and lunch on the way.
 - Students will need to bring their own packed lunch (but please do not supply energy drinks) and may bring a small amount of money if they would like to buy a snack when they reach New Hunstanton, after they have completed all their collection data.

- **Arrive at New Hunstanton at approximately 12.45-1pm**
 - Fieldwork on the beach to include quadrats, beach profile, observation of management.
 - Students will then move to the promenade/Green/town area where they will record the stall types and other variables to answer their human geography hypothesis.

- **Leave New Hunstanton at approx. 3-3.30pm**

Arrival time back at PWS coach park will be approximately between 5-5.30pm depending on traffic. We will ask students to advise you, by phone, of our exact return time to facilitate pick up.

The cost of this visit is £17.50 per student and this covers the cost of the coach and parking. In accordance with legislation this has to be described as a voluntary contribution. However, if we do not receive adequate monies to cover the costs, the trip may not be able to run.
