Water Safety Reminder

Swim in	Never swim in rivers, lakes, reservoirs or quarries unless it is a supervised, designated swimming area.
Cause	Cold water can cause cold water shock, making it difficult to breathe or swim, even on a hot day.
Avoid	Avoid jumping or diving into open water – hidden objects and shallow water can cause serious injuries.
Don't go in	If you see someone in trouble, don't go in after them. Call 999 and ask for the Coastguard (at the coast) or Fire and Rescue Service (inland).
Remember	If you fall into water unexpectedly, remember: Float to Live – lean back, spread your arms and legs, and control your breathing.
Enter	Never enter the water when under pressure from friends.
Tell	Always tell someone where you are going and who you are with.
Look out	Look out for your friends and make safe choices around water this summer

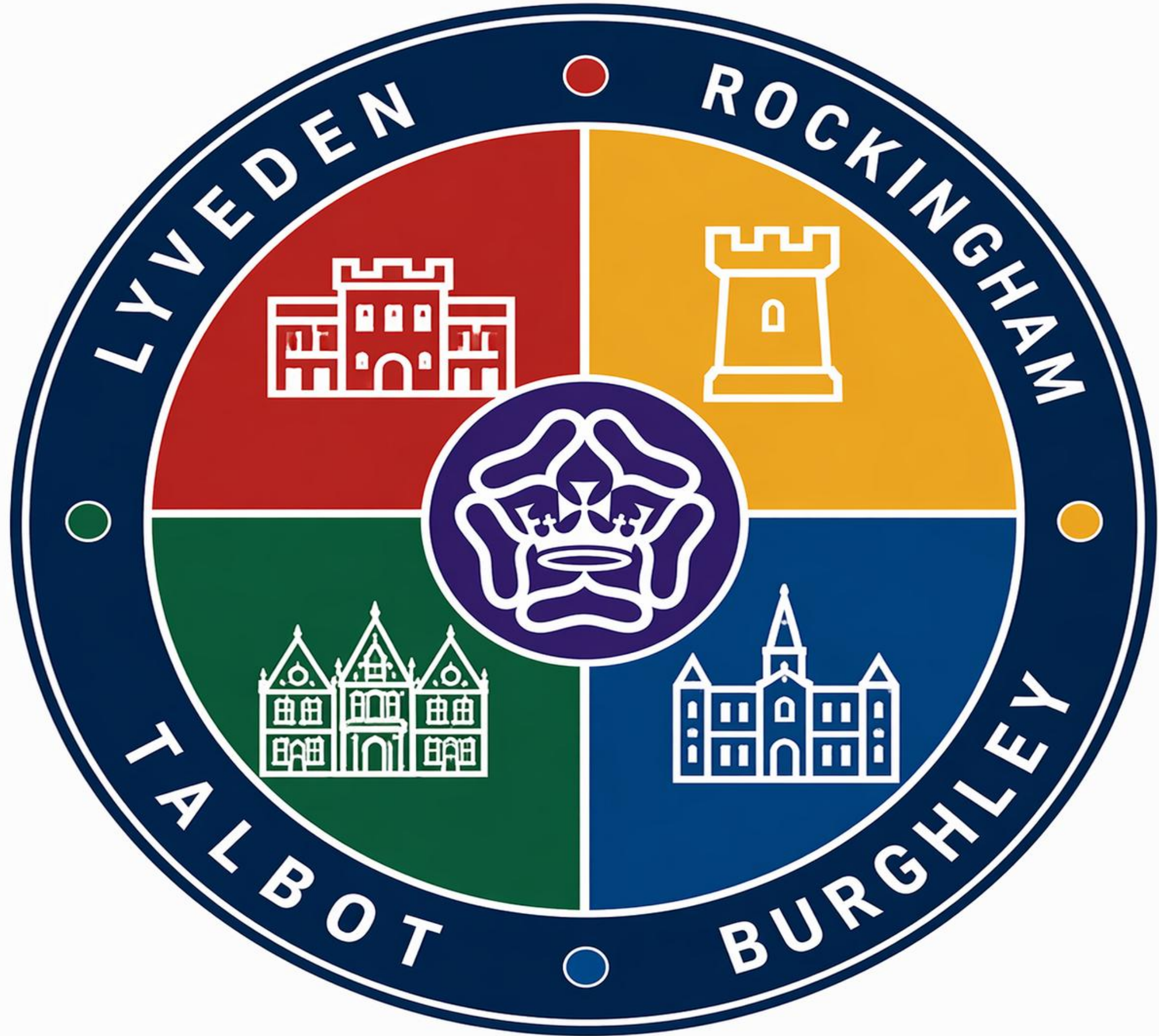

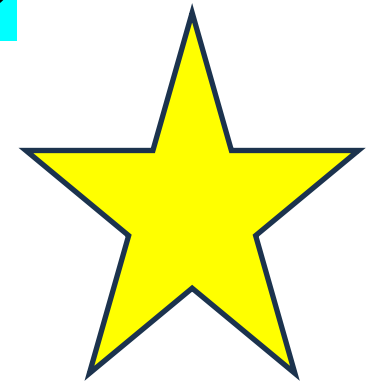

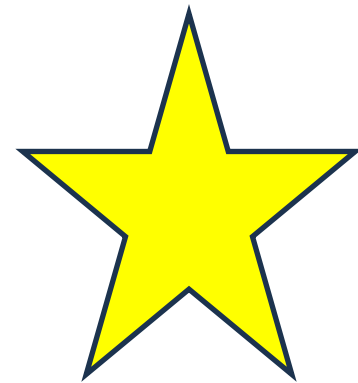
