Dear Parents/Carers,

On Wednesday February 11th, all Year 12 students will receive a presentation from a charity called The Consent Project that is focused on educating young people to understand and engage with the issues surrounding consent and sexual assault.

Each student will take part in a 1-hour session with the aim of empowering students to have the confidence and knowledge they need to make safe, healthy choices around sexual consent. The session will focus on the following:

- What is consent?
- How do we identify consent?
- What rights and responsibilities do we have?
- How are sexual consent laws in the UK defined?
- How can we give support and where can we get it?

Additionally, later in the term on Wednesday March 11th students will receive a presentation from Northamptonshire Integrated Sexual Health Organisation. During this sexual health presentation, students will receive information about contraception and sexually transmitted illnesses. These issues will be approached in a positive and open manner. We aim to give students relevant information in a matter-of-fact way to clear up any misconceptions and to build on information they will have received in the main school.

At the end this presentation, students will be given the opportunity to be screened for chlamydia and gonorrhoea if they so wish. I must emphasise, this is optional, and it is achieved through a simple urine test. The point of doing this is to show students how simple and easy the test is.
