Statement of Entry - Examinations

A summer 2026 statement of entry has been distributed on Fri 06 March during registration time to all students with entries for examinations in Summer 2026.

All students have been asked to check the following:

- Name on the Statement of Entry
 - This should be your legal name, not your preferred name
 - The name shown on your statement of entry will print on your qualification certificates
- Date of birth
- Subjects
 - All subjects with exams in Summer 2026 should show on the statement of entry

Notes:

- The statement of entry can be taken home.
- It does not need to be signed or returned to school.

Tiers of entry for GCSE Maths/Science/Spanish/French:

- Students/parents/carers are advised to speak to their subject teacher if there is a query with foundation/higher tier for these subjects.
 - The tier of entry is not final for these subjects. Entry tiers have been set to mirror the recent mock exams.
 - Subject teachers may decide to change tiers once they have marked the mocks and had conversations with students/parents/carers.
