A Message from Mr Kennedy - Recently, I reminded all the main school students in assembly that phones must play no part in the school day. In line with our policy, if a phone is seen or heard, it will be confiscated and returned to the student at 3.20pm. If the phone has been confiscated three times in a term, the school will then ask the parent/carer to come in and collect it. This reminder was in light of the clearer government guidance that came out recently around phones and also due to a rise in the numbers of phones being confiscated each day. I am very pleased to say that the students have responded very well to this reminder and we have seen a significant fall in the use of mobile phones in the school day, with some days seeing no phones being taken off students at all.
