# How can I make revision meaningful?

## Most students waste revision time by doing this:

- Reading notes again and again
- Highlighting everything
- Watching videos without practising
- Saying “I know this” without testing themselves

## The problem?

- Your brain recognises the information... but **cannot RECALL** it in the exam.



## What should I do instead?

- **Test yourself** instead of rereading notes
- **Practice exam questions** under timed conditions
- **Find mistakes** and improve weak areas
- **Revisit topics regularly** over time

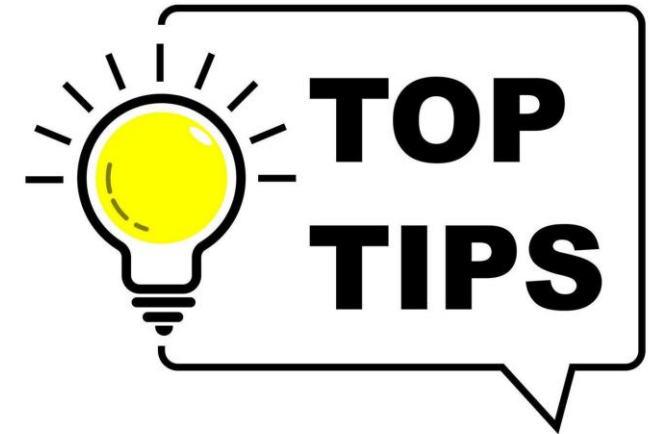
