As you prepare to transition into Sixth Form to study Sciences and Mathematics, we are delighted to invite you to apply for the **Oundle STEM Potential Programme**—an exclusive initiative delivered by Oundle School in partnership with **Imperial College London**.

Designed specifically for students entering Year 12, this multi-year programme will stretch your academic abilities beyond the A-Level curriculum and provide vital support as you prepare for competitive university applications in STEM fields.

**What does the programme involve?** Starting in late September 2026, you will attend **five Saturday events** per academic year at Oundle School. These sessions run from the morning into the early afternoon and feature:

- Dedicated university preparation workshops to strengthen your future applications

**Am I eligible?** To apply for the Year 12 entry, you must:

**How to Apply:**

- **Deadline:** Applications close on **Monday, 22 June 2026 at 23:59**.
- **Where:** Applications are hosted on Aspire, Imperial College London's portal.
- **Important:** Please register using a *personal* email address rather than a school one to ensure you receive all communications.
- You will need to nominate a parent/guardian and a teacher to provide a supporting reference (references are due by 29 June).

This is a unique chance to collaborate with like-minded peers, engage with top-tier academic material, and build a standout profile for university.
